MATH TUTORIAL PROGRAM

Children entering kindergarten and above may participate in our math tutorial program. Experienced teachers direct three private half-hour sessions which provide an outstanding opportunity to practice basic operations as well as problem solving and concept development. This program will promote the mastery of basic skills as well as offer challenges for those seeking enrichment.

READING TUTORIAL PROGRAM

Town's reading program serves as a model for educators. Our noted reading teachers bring their expertise to our SummerSault reading tutorial program. This is an exceptional opportunity to improve your child's reading skills without the pressures of the daily school routine. We offer three private weekly half-hour sessions that accommodate your child at any reading level.

Note: There is an additional fee for the Tennis, Math and Reading programs. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis.
